# EuroVintage: Carrick

January 2012



Carrick vineyards and winery are found within the unique microclimate of Bannockburn in Central Otago, a region that has been identified as a place especially suited to the fussy Pinot Noir grape. Because of the commitment to Pinot Noir within Bannockburn, there has been widespread development of substantial Pinot Noir viticultural and winemaking expertise. Carrick's fine wines are testament to this.

The hot dry Cairnmuir terraces, on which Carrick's vines are planted, produce grapes of optimal quality making wines which capture the special essence and vibrancy of Central Otago.

Steve Green and Barbara Robertson Green first planted the Cairnmuir Vineyard in 1994. The vineyards are managed by Viticulturist Blair Deaker, using sustainable viticulture practices, producing optimum quality grapes. The vineyards are in conversion to organics with BioGro certification.

Carrick have spent three years gaining official organic certification. From the 2011, all Carrick wines are officially certified organic although they have been producing organic wines since 2008.

<p><b>Carrick Riesling 2010</b></p> <p>Packed with sweet orange blossoms stone fruits and honeyed aromatics with a salty minerality adding complexity. The palate is layered with vibrant lush citrus characters which follow through to the long finish.</p>	\$18.72		
<p><b>Carrick Pinot Gris 2010</b></p> <p>Candied hints of spice are supported with layers of delicate florals, pears and leesy notes. The weighty core of the palate leads to a long clean finish of dried pears and papaya.</p>	\$21.84		
<p><b>Carrick Sauvignon Blanc 2011</b></p> <p>The palate is packed with fresh fruits which are supported by a zesty, crisp acidity and classic Central Otago minerality. The sweetness of fruit adds to the texture and weight of the wine which leads into a lingering finish of tropical fruits and grapefruit.</p>	\$17.41		
<p><b>Carrick Chardonnay 2008</b></p> <p>This Chardonnay is a subtle mix of stone fruit, nectarine and white peach aromas, with hints of sweet ground almonds and toasted oak. The complex flavours on the palate are complimented by a full bodied structure, with a lees influence. The vanilla and primary fruit characters complement the well balanced natural acidity, leaving the wine with a long creamy vanilla finish.</p>	\$21.84		
<p><b>Carrick Unravalled Pinot Noir 2009</b></p> <p>This wine displays lots of vibrant fruit from red cherry, raspberry to blackberries with a hint of spice underneath. The front palate is packed with sweet bright fruit with the same red cherries and blackberries on the nose following through to the flavours. The soft tannins give it lovely mid-palate weight with a dark cocoa finish.</p>	\$23.00
